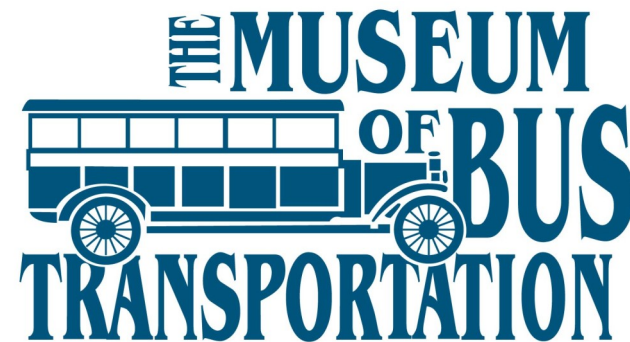

WHO WE ARE

The Museum of Bus Transportation was established in 1994 and is an IRS 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. All donations and contributions are tax exempt.

WHY WE EXIST

The organization was created to establish and maintain a first class, state of the art, national bus museum to display antique buses and important historical bus artifacts. These exhibits are intended to educate the public about the important role played by the bus industry in the growth and development of the United States of America.

WHAT WE SHOW

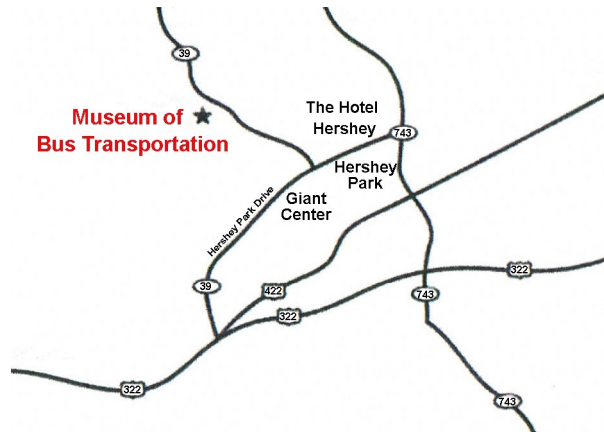
In early 2000, the Museum of Bus Transportation partnered with the Antique Automobile Club of America Museum, Inc., located in Hershey, PA. The joint museum opened to the public on June 30, 2003 and has welcomed thousands of visitors since that time.

The Museum of Bus Transportation has a long term 20-year lease for nearly 6,000 square feet of display area, offering room for up to 12 antique buses and other historical bus artifacts including toys, models, signs, photographs, schedules, and a beautiful time line.

LOCATION

The Museum is located at 161 Museum Drive, approximately 1 1/4 miles west of Hershey Park Drive on PA Route 39 in Hershey, PA. The Museum is close to most of the area's major attractions including Chocolate World, Giant Center, and Hershey Park.

The Museum is open daily from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM and is closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas, and New Year's Day.



RESOURCES NEEDED

JOINT OPERATING COSTS - Each month the Museum of Bus Transportation is responsible for joint operating expenses with the AACA Museum, Inc. Although the Museum of Bus Transportation does generate revenue through admissions and special events, extra donations are always needed to cover operating costs.

CONTRIBUTIONS AND DONATIONS - To maintain and enhance our exhibits at both the Museum and our Memorial Annex, additional contributions are needed. The Museum supplements revenues by offering renewable memberships for individuals and corporations.

Additionally, we are working to establish an endowment fund to also meet annual and long term goals.
